Summer 2019 Programs for Young Children

Summer@Peopleplace is offering an enriching camp-style program, available by the week, which provides your child with a developmentally appropriate first camp experience in an environment that is fun and nurturing.

Our teachers are highly qualified and experienced early childhood educators. Families will recognize many of the camp staff from our school year programs. They work as a team to ensure your child feels welcomed, encouraged, engaged and inspired.

A nutritious morning snack will be provided. Children staying into the afternoon should bring a lunch from home. Additional items for all campers include: sunscreen, bug spray, swim suit, hat and towel (for sprinkler play), diapers and wipes (if needed).

“Downstairs” Camp For 18 through 36 months

Summer@Peopleplace aims at helping our youngest campers form first relationships with a peer group and adults outside the home. “Downstairs” Camp focuses on socialization, exploration, and sensory experiences. It also offers an opportunity for children who will be attending Peopleplace Preschool in the fall to become familiar with the preschool environment. Toddler mornings will be filled with activities such as water and sand play, exploring the garden and green house, art, cooking, music, movement, and dramatic play. Group size is 8 children with two teachers.

“Upstairs” Camp For children 3-6 years

The Upstairs Camp will emphasize the simple joys of summer with lots of time for gardening, outdoor projects, sand and water play, as well as child directed exploration of our play areas and gardens. Weekly themes provide a focus for group projects and activities. The day is structured with a balance of indoor and outdoor time, organized activities and free play. Group size is 18 children with three teachers.

“Yurt” Camp For children 5 and 6 years old

This year we will offer a pilot *Yurt Camp* for 5 and 6 year olds the week of July 6. Children must register for M-Th 9-3:30 to fully embrace this outdoor experience. Science exploration, art activities, music, nature, and adventure will be the themes throughout the week! Two teachers will host up to 12 children.
